

School life. Russia and England

In Russia school begins on the first of September. And we have a nice tradition of the “first bell” on that day. In our country children begin to go to school at the age of six or seven. Most of all schools in Russia have numbers, not names, as schools in England have. We have classes five or six days a week. We have a lot of interesting subjects on the timetable: Nature Study, Maths, Economy, Art, Music, P. E., Handicraft, and English.

In England school begins on the first Tuesday of September. The English think that Monday is not a good day to start school. In Great Britain school begins at the age of five. Classes usually begin at nine. They have classes five days a week. Saturdays and Sundays are their days off. Schools in England have names, for example St. Mary School. There are two schools in Primary school: infant and junior.

In infant school children spend two years: from five till seven. Children spend much time outdoors. They play different

games, run, jump, and sing songs. Infant pupils learn how to use money in their classroom shop, how to get on with other children, how to read, count, write a little. But their classes are informal.

Junior schools are for children aged seven. They spend four years there, till they are eleven. Junior school is a real school. Pupils sit in rows and follow a regular timetable. They have English, Maths, History, Nature Study, Geography, Art, Music, Swimming, P. E., Religion, and Computing. Then they take their examinations and enter the secondary schools. There are some types of secondary schools in England. They are grammar schools, modern schools and comprehensive schools.

Pupils have school uniforms in England. It is an old tradition in the country.

Because of strict pandemic rules there are some special regulations in each Britain's school nowadays.
